





The President's Bark



Old Man Winter is beginning to relinquish his grip on the mid-Atlantic yet not without a display of his infinite power. Only a couple of days ago it was sixty degrees, sunny with robins grubbing about in the yard in search of anything with an early biological clock. That night the temperature dipped to 5 degrees and by mid afternoon there was 8 inches of snow on the ground.

Next weekend is the first NAHRA test in the Mid Atlantic region for 2001. In the last 18 vears we have experienced Tshirts and sunscreen to parkas and snow shovels with our season openers. I guess we consider ourselves should blessed compared to most of the northern regions. Actually, it is events such as these that create fond memories and introduce lasting friendships. Most anything can happen at a NAHRA field test. Watching the judges try to maintain their dignity and composure while

rolling their canoe during the opening test scenario. Seeing a dog seemingly line a difficult water blind, only to run up the bank, through the woods and jump into his crate. The pride and joy that we feel with our first ribbon or the welcome relief of earning the Master Hunter title. These things get into our blood. They are the things that money can't buy and time can't take from us; they are the memories of tomorrow.

I consider myself fortunate to have judged and run dogs in NAHRA events in most every region of the country. Tests are generally very similar in nature yet reflect the type of hunting inherent in the particular region. The NAHRA rule book in my opinion is the best among all of the testing programs. Any variable in testing is a result of the human element. Judges are a composite of what they have seen and done. Ideally they should be hunters, trainers and handlers with some common sense.

One of the issues discussed at the national meeting last November was developing a standardized iudges clinic format. Adrian Farmer, (Rocky Mountain Region, liaison) and Gary Willis. (Pacific North West, liaison) have been working on this project. The plan is to educate a team of certified instructors to bring greater uniformity to NAHRA tests. Judges will be required to attend one of these clinics every three years. It is also likely that judges will be required to have run and qualified dogs at the level they

wish to judge to become approved. The first draft looks really good, I am excited about getting it finalized and established.

The newly formed Rocky Mountain Region has asked Phyllis Giroux and I to judge their first Regional Field Test near Fort Collins, Colorado on May 5th. On May 6th we will be conducting the first judging clinic under the new format at the Colorado Division of Wildlife Headquarters in Denver. (read "Greetings from the Rocky Mountains" by Adrian Farmer, this issue).



Hello everyone—Happy spring!

I know, some of you are still snowed in and ice still covers your pond, but here, daffodils are poking through the mulch in my garden, and we have had a few nice days of spring-like temperatures in between the occasional snow flurries and cold rain. A few of our clubs have already run a field test and the new season is in full swing.

The office has been a-buzz with all kinds of activity; field test applications, the judges list, membership applications and renewals, and of course the NAHRA NEWS. It seems everyone forgot about sending in things they wanted printed this quarter, so there have been a few delays. The next deadline to submit materials has been extended a week to accommodate the delays. Please send your second quarter articles and ads by April 13th, and we can all get back on track.

I have a few reminders for all our field test secretaries out there, whether you're an old pro at it, or new to the position, please remember that your field test application is due into the NAHRA office eight weeks prior to your test. This means the judges you intend to use for your test, need to be contacted and confirmed ahead of time. If you send in a field test application without the judges filled in, the application is incomplete and can be rejected. Your application should also arrive with a photocopy of your insurance certificate. Your club's insurance coverage needs to allow for the use of live or popper ammunition. Please check with your agent to make sure you have this Many insurance companies are coverage. changing their policies in this regard, so make sure you have the coverage you need.

The information on your field test premium MUST match the information on the field test application. You cannot have a set of judges and a field test committee approved on the application, and have a different set listed on the premium. It is understood that *occasionally* there are changes, (hey, life happens), but all changes *must* be approved by the NAHRA office. It is a good idea to have your application approved before sending out the premium.

There could be all kinds of snags you are unaware of that get checked at the office. Judges and field test committee members, must be current NAHRA members, and if you are on the field test committee (this includes you, the secretary), you cannot be a judge for this test.

Judges who allow their membership to lapse three months or longer are required to retake and pass the judges test, if they intend on judging NAHRA events. As the field test chairman, or secretary, if you make sure all of these points are in order, prior to submitting your application, approval can be issued without delay, (The more often I have to check on all this stuff, the longer the whole process takes for everyone). Having all your ducks in a row, allows you to have time for all the other preparations that require your attention, and your premium can be mailed with plenty of time for responses.

Clubs, whose membership dues are not paid and their membership with NAHRA is not current at the time their field test application is submitted, may not be approved to hold the test. Club memberships are due either January 1st or July 1st of each year. Notices are sent out to the club rep on file. If you change your officers and the NAHRA representative changes, you need to inform the office.

If you have questions, and need help, please contact your club officers, your liaison, or call me at the office.

At this time we are still in need of two regional Liaisons, one in the southeast and one in the south central regions. Clubs in these regions who would usually coordinate their test dates with their liaison, need to coordinate their dates with Dave Cannings as well as the NAHRA office. And if you know of anyone in those regions who would like to serve as a Liaison, please communicate with Dave Cannings.

Well, that's all for now, I'm sure I will be talking to you soon. Be kind, be safe, remember to have fun.



From San Joaquin Hunting Retriever Club - In Modesto, CA

How is your club introducing new prospects to NAHRA?

At the start of each new year your club should set in motion a plan to introduce new dog owners to NAHRA. This list may include people buying new puppies, hunters that want to keep their dog in shape, those that just want to learn a positive approach to training a dog, dog owners that participate in competing field tests and even a few show owners.

One way that we do this is by holding several "Fun Days" each year. These events basically have nothing to do with NAHRA. We want to invite dog owners and introduce them to the club and to watch other well trained dogs do various items. Thereby, the new people will ask about our club affiliation and us. Most of our new members do not join at a field test. But our goal is still to introduce them to NAHRA and what we consider one of the best field test programs in existence.

These events can include several different items throughout the year. Our first event is in February. We have what we call a "Shoot to Retrieve". This basically consists of teams of one dog and two people. Six to eight chucker are put in a field and each person is given four shells. You have twenty minutes to get four chucker. Points are awarded for unused minutes, unused shells, number of birds downed, the dog for steady to flush and deliver to hand. The winning team will each get a large trophy belt buckle with the name of the event, year and a picture of a lab on it. You might not believe how this attracts interest in this event. Each member usually invites a non-member to shoot with him over his dog.

In April we have our super singles competition. This consists of six different and harder single marks. We invite a judge in for this event. They will set up a mark and all dogs will run the mark. All dogs get a least four marks before any callbacks are given. Then the judge will keep running more marks

until they have a clear winner for that day. Basically it is very simple, run straight, run true and return in the same line and you will win. We have a large trophy for this event. It is a perpetual trophy that each year the name of the dog and the owner are engraved on the trophy for all to see. That year's winner gets to keep the trophy in their house. You are able to see all the past years winners. Makes for great conversation during the whole year and allows the winner the ability to introduce others to what they have won and how they can participate.

In June we will have a fast dog competition. This consists of setting up single marks and timing the dog on the retrieve. The fastest dog over several retrieves wins. This is a great way to introduce new members since we do not grade style, deliver to hand or any other item but speed. The dog is timed from the time they leave the line until the time they cross back over the line with the bird. Makes for lots of laughs and a fun time by all.

We then, will have a day just to trap shoot and to play several different games, like bumper toss and barbecue. This is for all the family members. The Trap shoot is usually very well attended and has a large group of first time shooters. We are blessed in our club, by people that love to teach others to shoot and how to handle a firearm properly. It is also the best way to keep children involved and wanting a pup, so they can run them in the events.

Interspersed with these events, are two field tests. One test in March and one test in September. We also try and have training days along with our sister club "Delta Islands". That club has been the best at putting on training days.

Usually there is an event each month where we can invite new prospective members too. Our goal is to introduce people to a better way of handling dogs and to show how we protect the environment with a well trained dog.

Keep it fun, simple, and you will have a great year.

Recipe Corner

Chino Chopped Vegetable Salad

By Wolfgang Puck, professional chef

INGREDIENTS

Mustard Vinaigrette

- I Tblsp Dijon Mustard
- 3 Tblsp sherry wine vinegar
- ½ cup extra virgin olive oil
- ½ cup almond or safflower oil
- Salt

- Freshly ground white pepper Salad
- I Tblsp olive oil
- ½ cup diced fresh artichoke bottoms
- Salt
- Freshly ground white pepper
- ½ cup each of diced carrots, diced green beans, diced red onion, diced celery, diced ripe avocado, fresh corn kernels
- ¼ cup peeled, seeded, & chopped tomato.
- 4 tsp grated Pamesan cheese

I cup mixed greens of your choice (cutly endive, chicory, baby lettuce), cut or torn into bite-size pieces.

EQUIPMENT

- Small and large bowls
- Whisk
- Small skillet
- Fine mesh basket
- Medium sauce pan

DIRECTIONS

- Prepare the vinaigrette: In a small bowl, comine the mustard & vinegar. Slowly whisk in the oils. Season to taste with salt & pepper and set aside. Whisk again when ready to serve.
- Prepare the salad: In a small skillet, heat the olive oil. Season the diced artichokes lightly with salt & pepper & saute until al dente, about 3 minutes. Transfer to a large bowl & let cool.
- Blanch the carrots & beans by placing them in a fine mesh basket. Set the

- basket into a pot of boiling salted water & cook until al dente, 2-3 minutes. Plunge into cold water to stop the cooking process. Drain, cool & add to the artichokes. Add the onion, corn & celery.
- 4. When ready to serve, dice the avocado & the tomato & add to the other vegetables. Reserving a little vinaigrette, toss the vegetables with the vinaigrette, sprinkle with the grated cheese & toss again. Correct seasoning to taste.
- Toss the greens with the reserved vinaigrette & season with salt & pepper to taste.

Presentation: Divide the salad greens among four salad plates. Mound the chopped salad on the greens & serve immediately.

To prepare ahead. Through step 3, refridgerate until needed.



Who's The Boss.....The Marshal!

As the marshal goes, so goes the test. There is a lady in the Northwest Region who exemplifies what a Marshal "OTTA BE". She belongs to the Spokane Bird Dog Association and usually Marshals during some part of every NAHRA Hunting Retriever Field Test. When she travels to other Field Tests with her husband Ted, Claire is more than willing to line up the handlers and give out the instructions of how this stake will be run. The lady I'm referring to is Claire Snodgrass. In my opinion it will be hard to find a better Marshal than this lady.

Over the past few months I have been putting some material together about how, and what I believe a Marshal's Duties are, so I thought about some of the Marshals I have encountered while running my dogs at some of the NAHRA Field Tests. There are a lot of good Marshals in the NAHRA organization but none of them covered the criteria for marshaling better than Claire. The next task was to make a list of tasks she performs when marshaling.

As Marshal of a stake at a Field Test, the job is not only to get the dogs to the line, but also to make sure the stake runs well mechanically. The stake should run in order but when we are blessed with pros and amateurs running more than one dog in various stakes it makes the task of Marshalling even tougher. When the Marshal has three stakes Started, Intermediate and Senior running simultaneously; the Senior stake should take precedence over the Started and Intermediate, and the Intermediate should take precedence over the Started stake.

How does the Marshal run the dogs in order of the draw? The best bet is to run the stake as expeditiously and fairly as possible. The Started and Intermediate don't have to run in order but the Senior should be in order as close as possible, and this can be done if you are up to the challenge.

AS MARSHAL OF THE STAKE, YOU'RE DA BOSS...... YOU MAKE IT HAPPEN!

As a marshal, you must keep the stake moving, you can't do this sitting on the line talking to the judges or in the gallery talking to the audience and just calling numbers. You have to work from the line back, and rattle some cages!! By all means don't be intimidated by the handlers or judges. If you feel your running order is right then go with it and make it happen, most handlers and judges are cooperative if you are organized and positive.

There are several duties of the stakes marshal, I have tried to list as many as possible. I hope that these will help when it's your turn to be the GENERAL (marshal):

Dogs to the Line:

Call the dog to the line. (Make sure you *verbally* call dogs/handlers to the line and holding blind. Have a dog in the holding blind at all times and make sure one or two dogs/ handlers are getting ready for the holding blind. (Example: Dog #1 to the line, Dog #2 in the holding blind, Dogs 3 and 4 get ready, etc.)

Always announce the number of the dog coming to the line to the judges.

If you are marshalling a Started or Intermediate and suddenly handlers show up that are running dogs in other stakes and want to be squeezed in, run the dogs you have called to the line and the holding blind. Reorganize (and verbally announce) your new running order. The pros and handlers with more than one dog are usually very cooperative and will accommodate you as the running order best suited to expedite the stake. This also goes for marshalling senior stakes where a handler / pro running in more than one stake (just another reminder, don't let them intimidate you), put them in an order which will not disturb dogs you have already called to the line, and will as fairly as possible expedite the field test.

Scratches:

This information is obtained from the field test secretary. Announce this information to the judges and handlers.

Test Dog:

This is one of the toughest chores for the first series of tests, since most of the dogs are in competition. Be prepared to find one quickly before the stake starts so the test dog will be ready. Remember, you as marshal choose the test dogs. However, the judge may wish to determine the qualities required for the test dog and may have suggestions for a particular dog. Then you comply with the judges.

B- Dog:

In the senior stakes there may be an honor series. Be sure you have a by-dog available. The by-dog will run the series for the honor dog.

Pick-up-Dog:

In the event that a running dog doesn't complete the water series, it is advisable to have a pick-up-dog close to the line. If there is a no bird, the dog can retrieve the hard-to-get bird and the other throwers can retrieve the easier

to-get bird, which will expedite the stake's mechanics.

Special Instructions:

It is your responsibility to let all the handlers know if there are any special instructions from the judges for the test. Write down and hang it in the holding blind. (Clothesline pins are good for hanging notes in holding blinds).

Rotation:

Usually at the RAW Invitational, and at some of our larger Field Tests the judges select the rotation of the dogs. If they select a rotation, let the handlers know, put it on a piece of paper and clip it to the holding blind so everyone knows.

No Bird:

Check with the judges when to rerun the dog., usually after three dogs. Make sure you clearly announce the new running order after you have determined the new order.

Blind is Down:

This also your responsibility to make sure the blind is always planted. Let the judges and the handler in the holding blind know when the blind is down.

Call Backs:

It is a good idea to announce the callbacks quickly. If the dog is dropped, the handler can plan the rest of the day.

Next Series:

Find out the location of the next series will be so no one gets lost.

When the judges are setting up the next tests, keep the gallery away from the judges so they won't be disturbed. The gallery can go to the line when the scenario is being demonstrated.

The gallery should be able to see the dogs tested in a location that will not disturb the dogs or the handlers. The gallery SHOULD NOT WEAR WHITE OR BE DIRECTLY BEHIND THE HANDLER WHEN THEY HAVE TO HANDLE THE DOG. Movement of the gallery and clothing colors may cause the dog to misread a handlers command. You as the marshal have the power to ask for this situation to be corrected.

If a handler has a question regarding call backs, he/ she should direct the question through the marshal and you can ask the judge to either talk to the handler or try to get the information for the handler. If the handler is insistent on talking to the judge then be as diplomatic as possible to handle this situation.

Marshals are responsible for feeding the judges, gunners and bird throwers. These lunches are provided. Let the handlers know well in advance when you will feed the workers so they don't have to put their dog away again. (Example: Dog #3 to the line #4 in the holding blind, lunches will be delivered after #4 runs. When the lunches are delivered make sure dog #5 is in the holding blind so the trial can start again.)

Re-bird:

You should know when it is time to re-bird the bird throwers. Again, announce to the handlers (dog #3 to the line; Dog #4 in the holding blind; we will re-bird after dog #4, etc.) After the birds are delivered to the throwers, have the next running dog in the holding blind and re-announce the running order.

Try to keep the handlers informed of the running order so their dogs don't have an undue wait before testing.

Depending on the size of the stake, make sure you have relief bird throwers and know in advance when you will relieve them. This should be communicated with the test chairman or chief marshal. Make sure you have boats, anchors, oars, and blind markers ready for the appropriate series so the series can start with a minimum of delay.

Comforts for the Marshal

Two-way radios, rain gear for you and extra for the handlers who forget theirs, lawn chair(s), towels, thermos with the judges coffee, cooler filled with ice, pop and bottled water, hat and sun screen. Pencil, paper, magic marker, paper clips or clothes line to hang notes in the holding blind. Garbage bags, zip lock bags (just a couple), float board for blinds.



From the NEW Rocky Mountain Region...

Greetings from The Rocky Mountains!

Well, ... I'm not really that cheerful. Hunting seasons are over. There's snow on the ground, most of our waters are still frozen, and I'm stuck in a late-winter lull, reading and rereading mail order catalogs to identify equipment that I "must have" before next hunting season. Of course, dog training starts in earnest soon, and there's really lots to do because we are a new Region.

The Rocky Mountain Region of NAHRA was created by regional realignment last year, and is comprised of four states: Colorado, Wyoming, Utah, and New Mexico. Currently there are four NAHRA clubs in the Region, three in Colorado and one in Wyoming. Since becoming Regional Liaison in November, I have received email from several retriever owners in Utah and New Mexico concerning upcoming field test in those states, which are nonexistent because there are no clubs to sponsor such tests. So, if you are possibly interested in starting a new club, please call me (apfarmer@verinet. com; 970-226-6192) for information. There's lots of help available from the NAHRA office and from the other clubs in the Region, and you might be surprised at how easy it is to get started on a venture that is not only fun, but will also significantly improve the hunting skills of your retriever.

Our first Regional field test is being planned for 5 May 2001 near Fort Collins, Colorado. A total of 19 Started and 11 Intermediate dogs have qualified for the Regional, which is being sponsored by Colorado Hunting Retrievers. This will be run as a licensed field test, so other handlers, in addition to the Regional qualifiers, who wish to run a dog at the Started or Intermediate level may participate. LaFarge, a

local and environmentally progressive mining company, owns the field test grounds. The actual test site is a restored area on which LaFarge has constructed a large wetland complex. The wetlands on this site will rival any 'concept' pond constructed especially for dog training, including numerous points and islands. So, the judges will have ample opportunity to design tests that will be both challenging and interesting.

We are fortunate to have Jack Jagoda and Phyllis Giroux coming to judge at our first Regional. We are a relatively young Region, many members have been involved with NAHRA for only a short time, so having Jack and Phyllis attend will give us an opportunity to learn more about the organization from its top people.

The day after the Regional Field Test, on Sunday, 6 May 2001, we will host a NAHRA judges clinic at the Colorado Division of Wildlife Headquarters in Denver. Jack and Phyllis will conduct this clinic. Announcements for the clinic have not been mailed yet, but if you're interested in attending this clinic, please contact me for details.



From the South West Region...

The hunting season is over and we, in the Southwest region, are in the spring testing season. By the time you have received this newsletter in the mail, we will be ending this spring run.

We will be having a test almost every weekend from February 10-11 to April 7-8. This spring season is popular with the "snowbirds" from the Northwest region. They can get out of the snow and ice, running in lots of NAHRA tests in a small space of time. We all look forward to our northern friends; discussing the different breeding in our dogs, comparing the passing hunting season and talking over our different testing situations.

Speaking of the passing hunting season, it reminds me that I am going to get on my soap box and discuss something that I feel a real passion about, what the NAHRA game is all about, the best all around hunting dogs in North America.

I was at a popular training site during this past hunting season and ran into a NAHRA buddy. He had stopped on the way home from hunting and was doing a little training with his dog. I talked to him about how his dog was doing and we discussed the hunting season and how he had fared so far. Then he uttered the phrase that made me speechless, (which does not happen very often). He said that hunting with his dog was ruining his dog for the tests so he was not going to let his dog hunt any more. What I replied to him was, "Hmm, really". But inside I was fuming. I had to remind myself who I was and not to loose my cool.

On the drive home, all I could think of was, "Is this what has become of NAHRA, when hunting ruins our dogs? Is this where the program has headed? What is wrong?"

I got on the phone and e-mail the next couple of nights and talked to friends who hunt and run their dogs in NAHRA field tests. I asked them casually how their hunting was going and how the dog fared in the field. I heard many comforting stories that made me realize that the NAHRA program is working for our dogs.

I heard the story of the pheasant that was shot and sailed on for over 100 yards to land near a ditch. The hunter put his NAHRA dog into the area. The pheasant had obviously been only nicked and had hit the ground and started running. The dog trailed the bird into a ditch and then where it had run out of the ditch into a thick stand of tules. The dog trailed, caught the bird and then proudly delivered it to hand.

Then, I was told about the dove hunt where the hunter hit a double on doves. One landed close, but the other landed in a field that was off limits to hunters.

The NAHRA dog was able to enter the field the hunter could not and retrieve the dove that otherwise would have been lost. And speaking of lost, there was the three hunters down in southern California that shot five ducks, all out of one flock that had tried to land amongst their spreads; one guy got a single, the other two each shot doubles. With all their concentrating on shooting the birds, they did not mark where the birds fell. Their NAHRA dog did and brought in all five birds after some hunting in heavy cover. The hunter remarked to me that without their NAHRA dog, they would have most certainly lost most of the birds.

Another pheasant hunter excitedly told me that his NAHRA dog saved him loads of walking and lots of birds. "IF I had not had my dog with me, I would never have known the birds were there, and would have probably walked right past them. I could see by his body language that he was on one, he would creep up on it and then flush it out, and bring it to me."

One hunter told me about how he was done duck hunting for the day at the wildlife area and was on the way into the parking lot when he ran into another hunter who was looking for some birds he had shot. He had almost given up, there was thick stands of tules to fight and he was afraid he would never find them. My hunting friend offered to send his dog out to find them. He sent his NAHRA dog out into the general area and told his dog to hunt them up. The dog crashed into the stands of tules, hunted and found three ducks.

So, after hearing these stories, I realized that the NAHRA program was, in fact, working well. Most of the hunters from the stories above do not train or test during the limited hunting season. They let the dogs do what they were trained and bred for, what the NAHRA purpose is for; conservation animals that can fulfill the hunter's needs in the field, to recover the bird as quickly and efficiently as possible, to create the least amount of disturbance in the marsh and field and to give the hunter the maximum amount of time to actually take the game. And the guy who is not going to let his dog hunt because it ruins him for tests? Well, I think I will give him a call, talk to him and show him how hunting IS training for our NAHRA field tests.

Well, now I can get off my soap box and present to the NAHRA world the SW Region members who worked so hard during the year 2000 and have qualified to run in the 2001 Southwest Regional Event!
