President's Bark



NAHRA has led the field with new ideas since its conception in 1984. We have always been copied yet never equalled. The non-competitive concept of retriever testing was laughed at in the beginning. Today, the two largest breed registries in the country are operating similar programs. NAHRA created the all expense paid annual Invitational Field Test for the top 30 NAHRA dogs in North America and the Brass Band Award for Started and Intermediate dogs that qualify six times in a calendar year. NAHRA is not a breed registry. NAHRA's purpose is testing and rewarding hunting retrievers and maintaining a record of working accomplishments for the hunter. The newest and perhaps the most exciting project is a pedigree service that will list all of the working accomplishments of titled dogs. The pedigree will show all of the American Kennel Club, Canadian Kennel Club and NAHRA titles on one pedigree.

This is the first time that any such record has been available and it is quite unlikely that any of the breed registries will care to copy this one. The pedigree will be available January 1, 1989. The certified pedigree will be compiled from the same stud books used to generate AKC and CKC pedigrees.

During the first three years of NAHRA Licensed Field Tests, 54 dogs achieved Master Hunting Retriever (MHR) titles. 73 dogs earned Working Retriever (WR) titles and 749 dogs received Started certificates. The first six months of 1988 we had 20 new MHR's, 58 WR's and issued 85 Started certificates.

There has been an increase of over 30% in the number of field tests held this year compared to that of 1987. Our judging staff has increased by 20% giving us a published Judge's Points List in excess of 300. We have recently introduced a special newsletter mailed to each NAHRA judge with helpful suggestions on judging to ensure a national philosophy.

Congratulations to the first Brass Band qualifiers Ann and Tom Rothe from Anchorage, Alaska and Pioneer's Princess Perdition, the first dog to earn 30 points in Intermediate testing in 1988. Silverbrook's Penny Anna is the first Started dog to accumulate 15 points in 1988. Penny is owned by David Wease of Lorton, Virginia.

I have asked that clubs submit field test dates for 1989 by November 1st. Please urge your club to select dates for next year so that they will be included in the 1989 coming events list to be distributed next January.

As always, your support is greatly appreciated; NAHRA is alive and prosperous.

NEWS

From Our Readers

Dear Editor:

I felt it necessary to write about a problem which seems to plague many a field test secretary and field test committee. When premiums are mailed, they must include a specified closing date and time. (See page 9 in NAHRA Procedures and Regulations.) Our club, Navesink River Hunting Retriever Club, closed entries seven days before the field test date, but countless phone calls and a few entries dribbled in shortly after the closing date.

The tardy entries can cause quite a problem. Everyone must be aware of the fact that birds, ribbons, and ammunition must be ordered and purchased before the field test. A catalog or list of all participating dogs must be

typed in the *order drawn*. Is it fair to add a late entry to this drawing? Our field test committee thinks not. What about the people who show up the morning of the field test and wish to enter? Again our field test committee said no. We agreed previous to the field test date that each dog should get a shot flyer, and we ordered a few extra birds in case of fly aways. Would it be fair to take these late entries the morning of the field test and not have enough birds to last the weekend? Would you like to have a bird which has been used an excessive number of retrieves? We didn't think so. Is it fair to take an entry over the phone and have a handler pay his entry fee and fill out entry forms the morning of the field test? Our field test committee also said no. If we did allow this, and the entries did not show, it could mean a significant loss of money to the club which has paid for the items necessary for that dog's tests. A field test committee must expect to get a few scratches for bitches in season. But, all other entries must be counted on to show and items needed for the tests must be there the morning of the test. The items paid for, such as postal fees, land rental fees, judges' food, travel, lodging, ammunition, birds, NAHRA application fees, ribbons, etc., all must be paid if the entry shows or not. This is not a small bill for a club to

pay. Even a basic no frills field test with three categories and only 65 dogs easily costs over \$2,000.00 to run.

To add to this problem, I wish to ask all handlers, when you fill out your entry forms please do it legibly. Incomplete or incorrect forms, as stated in NAHRA General Procedures and Regulations, page 10, shall not be processed by NAHRA and shall be returned to the field test secretary. This entry form is NAHRA's official entry form. When you pass the standard at a field test, your judges initial and date this form and it gets mailed along with a list typed by the field test secretary to NAHRA to be entered into NAHRA's computer. This entry form is a record of your dog's performance; if it is incorrect, you may have problems getting your titles when your dog completes a category.

The field test secretary knows the job will take a lot of time and energy before, during and after the field test. And, I will admit, I do make mistakes too. I will accept responsibility for my mistakes but, I'm sorry, I cannot accept responsibility for your mistakes. So, please fill your entry form out in full and sign it. And please mail it in on time.

Ask the Doctor

Q: My lab has had two seizures in the last few months. Should I quit hunting her or should I start her on medication?

A: Seizure activity may be caused by a wide variety of factors but the most

common cause is epilepsy. The seizures can vary widely in severity and manifestations. During a seizure the dog may be spacey momentarily, or may fall over and thrash about, or might even become aggressive.

Most seizures last only a few minutes, and within 20 minutes the dog is pretty much back to normal. If the animal is having longer seizures or repeated seizures it should be seen by a vet immediately. Be careful when handling the seizing animal because it may not recognize you and try to bite.

I recommend placing a dog on anti-convulsant medication when the seizures are occurring one or more times per month. If the interval between convulsions is longer than a month, it is difficult to evaluate how much the medication is helping.

An exception to this recommendation concerns the dog who retrieves in water. Such a dog would be in imminent danger if a seizure occurred mid-retrieve. So, while I realize the odds against this are high, I prefer to minimize the risk even more by placing these animals, no matter how infrequently they have seizures, on anti-convulsant medication during the hunting season, then wean them from medication when they are not being worked over water.

Q: My dog has beat the end of his tail to a swollen, bloody, hairless mess. We've tried bandages and medicine but with little effect. What can I do?

A: Long tailed dogs that are confined to a kennel or hunt heavy cover can repeatedly traumatize the end of the tail by beating it against the kennel walls or brush. Unfortunately, the end of the tail is very hard to bandage adequately to protect the area while it heals. Even if it does heal, most of these dogs will injure their tail again every time they wag it.

The only effective treatment I've found is to amputate the damaged segment of tail. Regrettably, this isn't always a permanent solution as the dog may then damage the new tail end resulting in surgery again and again until the tail is too short to damage.

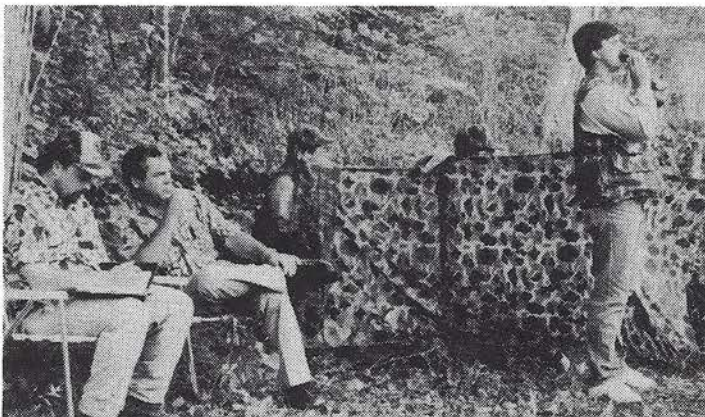

Wolters Says . . .

Years ago when I was really into the trout and salmon fishing scene I spent a lot of time in the Canadian Maritime Provinces, spending the family money, beating the water with poultry hackles for a paltry ten to twenty dollars worth of fish. Salmon fishing is a disease. It's much like playing the slot machines at Atlantic City. Playing a "one arm bandit" and casting a fly for salmon have two things in common. . .either your arm gives out or your money gives out!

It was great pleasure for me that Don MacPherson, of Fredricton, New Brunswick called me early in the year to suggest that I come up to Canada. . .at the height of the Salmon run and then stay on to give a combination training and NAHRA seminar to their new club. Tar didn't have to think about it too long and before we knew it Tar and I were on a flight north.

I won't bother to tell you much about the fishing, except each night I had to get into the Jacuzzi at the camp (we were roughing it) to relieve the muscle strain of my casting arm. Did you ever eat apple pie and ice cream in a Jacuzzi?

We had three days for the seminar. The first day we set up some Started and Intermediate tests for the dogs just to see them work. It is a new club in Fredricton and members as yet do not have any Senior dogs. I thought their young dogs did very well. It was a hot day so we only did water work, but the water we worked in was excellent for hunting tests. We could make it as easy or as tough as we wanted.

The weekend was seminar time. We had a mixture of a NAHRA discussion and training seminar. The thing that seemed obvious to me but not so obvious to my new Canadian friends was that their dogs were better than they thought and better workers than they were trainers. I felt that they were not taking their dogs along fast enough. For example the dogs were doing nice doubles but were not taught as yet to stop on the whistle. The club members appeared to be confused as to what

their dogs could learn in what order and how soon. Many of the folks were starting with grown dogs and did not have the advantage of that whole young puppy learning period.

There was one wonderful exception to all this and that was Roger Powers' puppy Target. Here was a five month old Lab pup that was one of the best young pups I've seen. We had the tests set up so that as Started dogs they would do the tests as singles and then for Intermediate tests there would be doubles thrown from the same places. Five month old Target ate up the singles. He was steady and went to work like an older dog. . .he sure seemed to know what he was doing. The folks thought I was crazy when I suggested that the pup do the Intermediate work. I was sure he could do it so we set him up on his first doubles. . .to the astonishment of all, except his handler, he did it like a pro.

Target was already into his baseball lessons and did them very well. For him, baseball in the yard training was not transferred as yet to the field tests. As the

trainer said, "I want him to know his baseball very well before I try it in the field. . .just so he won't fall into a mistake doing it before he is ready." Target was an excellent example to the handlers that they were "afraid" of their dogs. They were so afraid that they would do something wrong that they did "nothing." Seeing what Target can do I think got them turned around so they will bring their dogs along faster.

Three guys were responsible for starting the Fredricton Club. Don MacPherson has Golden Retrievers, Sterling White has Flat Coats and Tom Carton has a great working Wire Haired Pointer. If you want to see fun you should watch the style of the Wire Hair doing water work and handling.

The exciting part about this seminar was that it was not only made up of the Sunpoke Club of Fredricton but four members of the NAHRA Red Rock Hunting Retriever Club of Prince Edward Island and representatives of the Nova Scotia retriever group attended.

They saw the advantage of getting the three clubs going so they would have the beginnings of a small circuit in eastern Canada. They have a rosy future. Once they get their feet wet with their first NAHRA Licensed Started and Intermediate tests this September 17th and 18th they can begin to work toward a Licensed Senior test. Once that happens, handlers from the U.S. will flock up to Canada to run their dogs. If they run during the summer vacation it will be a big plus in getting the dogs, handlers and families up to the event. The weather is cool and there is plenty of land and water for training. The whole area is a vacation paradise and the exchange rate is very favorable for us. (We pay about 75 cents for their dollar.)

As for it being a sportman's paradise, Don points out that Grand Lake in N.B. is a major staging area for the Atlantic flyway with outstanding duck hunting. New Brunswick is the breeding ground and finest woodcock hunting anywhere. The fishing is great. . .well it can be. . .and if you fail at fishing I'm sure Don MacPherson's wife Karen will bake you a Grasshopper pie as she did for me.

Training Tips

by Gary Erickson

"What is Training?"



You hear the word training a lot but what exactly does it mean?

The dictionary definition is:

train (verb) 1. To coach in or accustom to some mode of behavior or performance. 2. To make or become proficient with specialized instruction and practice. 3. To prepare physically, as with a regimen. 4. To cause to take a desired course or shape. 5. To focus; aim.

All five of these definitions apply to what we do with dogs.

Beginning with the last (5. To focus; aim.), you must aim for an ultimate goal (a Working Retriever or a Master Hunting Retriever) and focus your attention on all

of the smaller goals that must be accomplished before your dog can achieve your expectations.

(4. To cause to take a desired course or shape.) Nobody can run before they can walk. You must prepare a course of action to achieve your individual goals. They must come in a certain progression to be successful. (Remember to always be proficient on land before repeating the same exercise in water.) 1. Enhancing of desires and instincts (puppy play). 2. Single retrieves, quartering and trailing (puppy training). 3. Formal obedience, field steadiness, delivery to hand, extended marks (Started) 5. Double marks, serious quar-

tering and trailing, trailing off marks, "Overs" - "Backs" - "Come Ins", sight blinds, patterns and cold blinds (Intermediate). 6. Multiple marks, stopping to the flush, trailing off blinds, combining marks with blinds and selection. (Senior)

(3. To prepare physically, as with a regimen.) The dog must first have the given conformation to be able to perform his tasks. Then, he must be in good physical condition to be able to perform at his peak. A dog needs plenty of exercise to keep in shape and to have the stamina to endure.

(2. To make or become proficient with specialized instruction and practice.) You must take each goal and determine what it takes for the dog to be able to perform the entire task. Example: Marking a long single. First the dog must be steady to get an adequate view of the bird going through the air. Second the dog must learn to use his eyes to get to the area of a long fall and then to use his eyes to get to the area of a long fall and then to use his nose to locate it. (This is called extending.) Finally, the dog must return with the bird. Each of these lesser goals must be repeated over and over until the dog can do all of them without hesitation. This is called conditioning which means the dog has become proficient with practice.

(1. To coach in or accustom to some mode of behavior or performance.) A good pup's first love is retrieving. You can

The folks at the seminar showed great enthusiasm for their dogs and the whole NAHRA program. At this stage of the club's development all the members are in the same boat. They are all training on the same level and working toward the same goal for their dogs and the club. As a result the club becomes a big social activity for them. . .that is when a club is fun. Proof of that was the Saturday night cookout. You never saw such food. Incidentally, between the fishing camp, the cookout and the Grasshopper pie I went home six pounds heavier.

Starting a club is not easy. The politics get in the way of the dogs. It really takes a few people who have their eyes focused "out front" to keep their objective in view. There are always those that feel a club is moving too fast. Both the Sunpoke and the Red Rock clubs have run into this problem of growing pains. I can't get a good explanation of what the "move slow folks" feel will go wrong. Maybe they feel that if something does get out of whack at a field test that Jack Jagoda himself will rush up to Canada and rip the NAHRA patches off their hunting shirts. You know a puppy can't make a water retriever without getting his feet wet. It's the same with a club. . ."get your feet wet" is the first step in running field tests.

Trainer's Notebook

As some of my friends say, I have "an overwhelming grasp of the obvious." They're not being too kind with that statement, but the fact is, in this case, I have stumbled onto something possibly so obvious that some handlers overlook it. I'm talking about the planning and organizing of your training sessions.

The average person who trains retrievers probably does so after work or on weekends. Because time is usually limited and training areas may be limited, most people

end up rushing out to their favorite grounds to set up a training session. The situation could and easily does develop in which handlers inadvertently fall into a rut. Which direction are your birds thrown? Which direction is the wind blowing? What type of cover are you using? Without advance planning and organization, handlers may be overlooking some important aspect of their training that will be encountered in the next event they run. The answer to this oft-occurring handler's problem -- a trainer's notebook.

The trainer's notebook should contain all of the pertinent information from the day's training set-ups. After a week or so of training, sit down and review the details. Is there something you didn't cover? These "oversights" could be costly down the road, so make a list of the possibilities you need to work on next week. Over a period of a couple of weeks, you can cover a lot of potential situations that you might otherwise overlook.

Some of the important details you'll want to include are: wind direction, direction of the throws (flower pot, inverted, etc.), angle of throws, distance of marks and blinds, density of cover, slope of land, and type of birds used. You may also note intricacies such as dry pops, diversionary birds, and others. In short, you need to note anything that will affect your dog's performance. Sometimes a simple diagram is a good way to show details.

It takes a certain amount of dedication to be organized in your training procedures, but look at it as a "labor of love." The next time old Rocky is sitting at the point of origin at a field test, he won't have to turn around and say, "Gee Boss, I haven't seen *that* in training in three months!" It takes some effort to be completely prepared, but the rewards are well worth it.

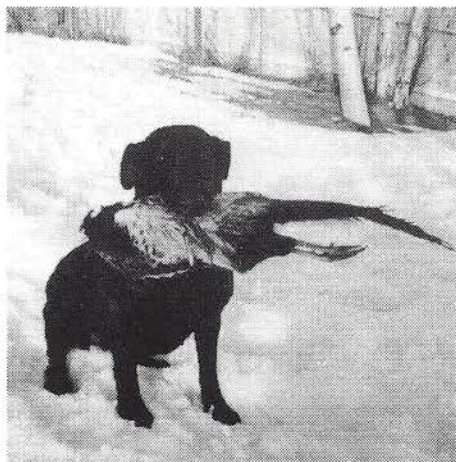

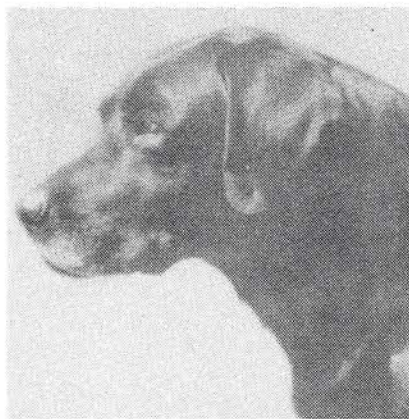

Last year, Rio dragged me out to our favorite hunting spots 93 times. I guess he figures if I go out to the field with 25 shells, he should pick up 25 birds. Rio can't tell you, so you'll just have to believe me, I was close.

At 4½ years of age and running NAHRA hunting tests for only 2 years, he has accumulated a total of 220 Senior points, thus giving us the opportunity to run the 1988 Invitational this year.

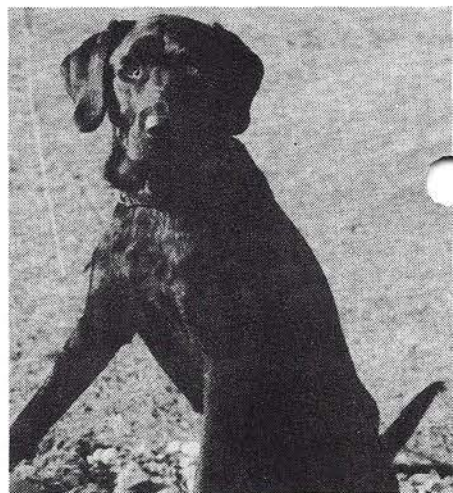

give an object to a four-week old pup and he will carry it around until he is tired of it. Initially, pup is carrying the object to please himself. You must condition him to please you if you are to be successful.

Getting pup to bring the object to you is "modifying" his behavior. You are changing what pup wants to do by getting him to do what you want instead of what he wants.

The approach needed to change pup's mind will vary from dog to dog. Some dogs need lots of positive reinforcement while others take physical force to eventually make them see the light.

Training is setting goals and focusing your attention on all of the smaller goals that comprise the big one, deciding on the path you need to take to get there, conditioning the dog physically to perform his tasks, repeating exercises until the dog is proficient at them and "modifying" the dog's behavior to meet your expectations.

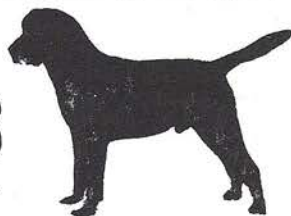

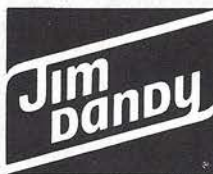

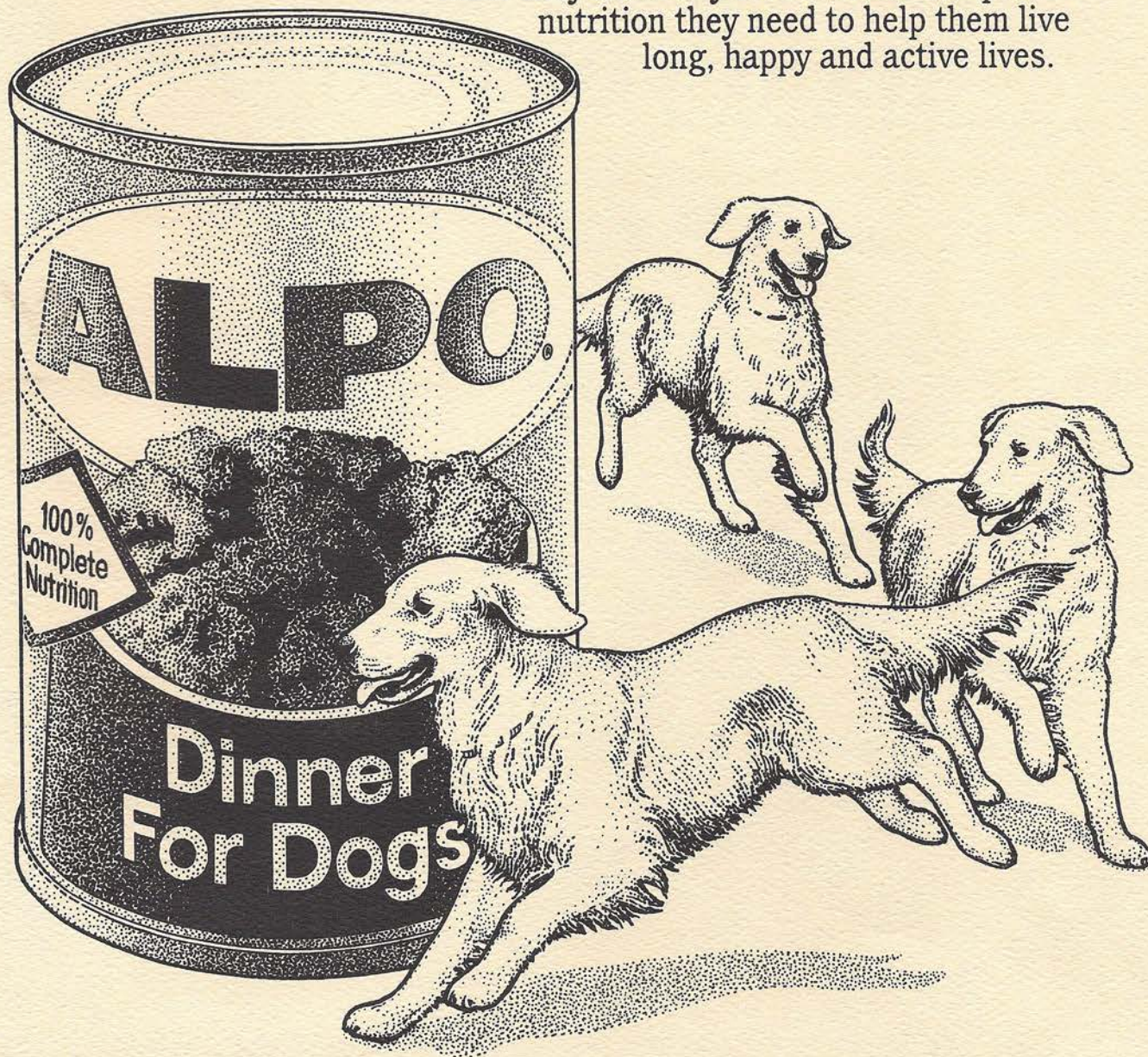
