



President's Bark by Jack Jagoda



Quite a bit has happened since the Invitational the first week in May.

NAHRA was represented at the Ducks Unlimited Great Outdoors Festival in Memphis, Tennessee. We had a booth at the event and took part in the retriever demonstrations. NAHRA members; Clarke and Dixie Pauly from Birmingham, Alabama, Herb Bittner, Don Evans and Marty Grabijas from Virginia, all pitched in to make the event a success.

The middle of August, I traveled to Hanover, Germany to do a retriever training clinic for members of the German Retriever Club. The main focus of the clinic was to introduce electronic training. Most of the people had a preconception of harsh collar training and robotic dogs in America. It took patience during the weekend seminar to dislodge the adversity, but it was worth the effort. As with any training device used incorrectly, there will be problems. We shared our philosophy in training techniques, trials and hunting with our retrievers. Although we had differences of opinion, we could all agree that dogs with strong inherent natural abilities and the intelligence and desire to learn were important.

The last few hours of the clinic, we set up NAHRA Started and Intermediate tests for all the dogs to run. Handlers and dogs had a great time. There was interest in running a NAHRA test in 1999. Who knows, the concept may spread through Europe.

I returned from Germany on a Thursday; and Friday I was running a NAHRA Double Senior at the Three Rivers Retriever Club test at Sandy Point, Virginia.

A week later I was off to Spokane, Washington to judge a NAHRA Started, Intermediate and Senior Field Test. on Friday evening I attended the fall Northwest regional meeting. The Regional Liaison, Phil Oldale took charge of the meeting and kept it on track. Dates were discussed for the 1999 schedule and support for new clubs in Idaho and Montana. The Region has enjoyed increased interest and participation in the last two years. Club representatives discussed hosting the Invitational in the year 2000. The meeting came to a close, some went to dinner, and others turned in to rest for the weekend testing.

I was pleased with the quality of dogs and handlers in all categories. Congratulations to the clubs, members and dogs of the Northwest Region. you can be truly proud of your accomplishments.

There is a chill in the air in many parts of the country which signals the arrival of the hunting season, and cold months to come.

In the southern regions of the country we are beginning the fall NAHRA tests, with hunting season soon to follow.

You should all be proud of the dogs you produce and assured that we will go afield with the most proficient hunters in North America


NAHRA Clubs, please remember that





A Miniature Retriever

If someone had told me a year ago that I'd be standing out in the middle of a field with my dog, guns firing off around me and ducks being thrown around, I'd have laughed in their face. I'll be the first to admit "Percy" doesn't look like a hunting dog, never mind a retriever. It's difficult to look seriously attached to a white miniature poodle. But don't let his size fool you; take determination, the desire to please and add some of what makes a poodle a poodle (a somewhat off the wall sense of humor) and you've got a dog who's got a few ideas of his own on how the job should be done.

Perhaps I should give you some history. Percy is nine years old and still participates in flyball and agility. In addition, he has an obedience title and has traveled around Canada performing as part of the Superdogs (a theatre style dog show). Last year he received his Versatility In Poodles certificate for his accomplishments. After some discussions with the chair of the VIP program, it was suggested that going for the Versatility Excellent certificate was definitely achievable if we looked at accomplishing a title in another discipline. After having eliminated a couple of options,

hunting was suggested and off we went.

A couple of my friends were training their dog and set up an introduction with their trainer. Soon we found ourselves signed up for classes, much to the amusement of my close friends and some of my classmates. Needless to say we've had to overcome some skepticism (including my own). After dealing with gunshyness, Percy eventually made up his mind that the noise of the gun was minor obstruction and thoroughly took to retrieving his birds with enthusiasm. Over the winter months and into the spring we continued our training between flyball and agility events. By the end of the spring he was working successfully. A few lessons of retrieving ducks in water, and the consensus was that he was ready for a real hunt test. A little bit of arm and leg pulling, and I found myself filling out entry forms, sending off registration



papers and packing my bags for Pennsylvania in August. What were we getting into?

The Southwestern PA Hunting Retriever Club test was the perfect introduction to what a hunt test was all about. The reception from everyone was really great. They were curious and supportive of our efforts. Unfortunately we ran into the "new test syndrome" - I was so nervous, I could hardly remember my own name, never mind my dog's. Percy took full advantage of being off leash and decided to do some laps around the field, until the bird was shown to him. He then came proudly back with his prize and was eager to do it again, but he had to wait until Sunday. That day was more fun! Each time he successfully returned, the gallery cheered and clapped - even the judges thought I had a fan club. It would have been absolutely wonderful had Percy retrieved the third bird, but by then he was interested in doing some socializing. Nevertheless, I was glad he had improved from the day before, and even though we didn't get to show off in the water, I know that we can do the job and will be back again.

Our biggest challenge is dealing with his small size in comparison to a labrador or golden retriever, but he has lots of tenacity and speed, and that inevitable sense of humor that manages to humble me, no matter what game we're playing. He's fun to watch (just ask all the folks at the Southwestern PA HRC who thought he was a rabbit), and he's a great worker when he puts his mind to it.

The whole experience was a great one - making new friends, getting lots of suggestions and encouragement, and with the weekend weather cooperating fully, it was a great time. The fact that we spent a weekend watching some really great dogs do their stuff and see a variety of breeds work, including a Dalmatian and a Weimaraner, really made the experience worthwhile.

Many thanks to all the people who helped us get started: Emily Cain for the suggestion, Roger and Nancy Stonell for support and encouragement, John Hamilton for his time and effort. Most of all, thanks has to go to Percy who, despite his size, has desire, determination and a great nose when he remembers to use it!

Keystrokes from Kent Repka...

n the last issue of the "NAHRA News", I listed the point information for U.S. Judges. Somewhere between my notes and the finished article. I deleted a comment about doing a similar report on Canadian judges, in the "next issue". Computers are great, but they only do what you tell them, not what you are thinking. I heard about my error at a recent Field Test when three of my friends from Ontario asked why I left them out. My intent was not to leave Canada out, but to do this report. here it is, and thanks for keeping an eye on me, at least I know three people read the information.

I mentioned in the earlier article that it takes many things to present a first class Filed Test. Suitable test grounds, help, birds, equipment and so many more things must be in place, but without judges nothing happens.

The current Canadian section of the Judges List contains 91 names. Here is the breakdown. There are five judges with 30 or more points (48 is the highest). Fifteen judges have between 20 and 29 points. Twenty one have between 10 and 19 points and forty one have between 1 and 9 points, and nine judges have no points.

The greatest number of Canadian judges, 26, reside in Quebec, followed by Alberta with 19, Manitoba with 13, Nova Scotia with 11 and New Brunswick with 9. There are 6 each in Ontario and Prince Edward Island, and 1 in British Columbia.


With 9 judges having no points, 82 pointed judges carry the majority of the work at the many Field Tests in Canada each year. Obviously, there are many members, on both sides of the border, who graciously accept judging assignments at other clubs and if the nine "forgotten" judges are in-

volved, the eligible "pool" is increased by almost 10%.

Hopefully, this will encourage others to step forward, take the judges test and make it known that they are willing to give others a chance to run their dogs.

If the hard working judges who accept assignments each year refused to come to your club, and you were unable to run your dog, wouldn't it be a shame?

Get involved, become a judge, you will enjoy it!



From the North Atlantic Region

After reading Kent Repka's article entitled "Do You Know What It Takes To Run a Field Test?", in the last issue of NAHRA NEWS and received several queries from local judges about how we are doing with judges in the Atlantic Canada, I decided to take a few moments and gather some numbers on the Canadian portion of our Region. This being Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and Prince Edward Island.

The North Atlantic Region has been associated with NAHRA for over 10 years and currently consists of four clubs with approximately 54 NAHRA members. Of these 54 members, 28 (or 52%) are found in the list of judges.

One judge has accumulated 48 points, while another has 37 points. Seven individuals have between 20 and 29 points. Eight have between 10 and 19 points. Nine have between 1 and 9 points and 2 currently have no points, but will be judging in August of this year.

I believe that these numbers indicate commitment of the people in our Region to NAHRA. Knowing we are a small region, participants realize that to survive, we must each set aside a day to judge, so that others may run their dogs. Long live NAHRA!







From AROUND ... World

The following letter was sent to NAHRA following a trip that Jack Jagoda and Phyllis Giroux made to Germany.

Seminar with Jack Jagoda and Phyllis Giroux, DVM.

On the 8th and 9th of August 1998, Phyllis Giroux and Jack Jagoda held a Retriever Training Seminar for the first time ever in Germany. The Seminar was organized by Adrian Lunn and Ilka Seffer and sponsored by Tri-Tronics. It was also the first time that (as far as the Author is aware) American Trainers had run a Training Clinic in Germany.

Due to a lot of peoples preconceptions about not only the American way of training but also about the use of electric training collars, the participation was limited.

Hunting in Germany is vastly different to the type of Hunting available to almost everybody in the USA. In Germany a Hunter has to rent a "Revier", which is a piece of land not less than 75 acres and no more than 300 acres for a period of 9 years. He is then responsible for the game on this land and has to pay the farmer for any damage caused by the game on his "Revier". This combined with the rent for the land can cost up to 30,000 DM/year (\$15,000). So you can guess what sort of people are doing the Hunting over here. The game hunted in Germany is mostly Roe Deer, Fallow Deer, Red Deer, Wild Pig, and Hare. Therefore the Retriever until recently has been much maligned by the "typical" German Hunter. The Hunters here like to think that they have found the perfect "allrounder" in the German Wirehaired pointer breeds, as a lot of them expect their dogs not only to retrieve but also track, point, do spaniel work and hunt and rip down wounded game (try that on a 150kg mad and wounded Wild Boar!)

There has been a lot of English influence in the Retrievers in Ger-

many and therefore the popular misconceptions about Americans and how their dogs work is also widespread in Germany. Combine this with the fact that Electric Training collars, due to massive misuse by most German Hunters, are very unpopular amongst the Retriever enthusiasts and you can imagine the job that Jack and Phyllis had in front of them.

The seminar started on Saturday morning with the participants trying out the dreaded electric collar on themselves, all of them were very surprised at the small amount of current going through the collar. Jack & Phyllis then proceeded to give them a demonstration with their two Labrador Retrievers, GMHR Six O'clock Scholar and MHR Maggie. The two dogs were totally opposite to that which we had heard of American Retrievers, instead of being robotic and "cowed" through being trained with the Electric Training Collar, they were happy hunting dogs, thoroughly under control and at the same time being allowed to use their hunting instincts and abilities to enable them to find the game (or in this case bumpers). After the demonstration, Jack and Phyllis went through the various stages of training a dog the "American Way". The Handlers present were very impressed by the fact that the dog was so controlled by Jack and Phyllis that it was unable to make a mistake, the use of the rope to train a dog was, for most of the participants a totally new concept and one that caused nearly as much discussion as the electric training collar. At the end of the day there was a dinner attended by all of the participants. Due to the fact that nearly all of the

Handlers were trying to come to terms with the fact that the collar is not a device for causing pain or for punishing the dog, but when used correctly, a useful Training device, the Dinner was a rather guiet affair.

On Sunday after going through the rest of their normal Training Program, Jack and Phyllis explained to those present what NAHRA is all about and why it was formed. We then received a thorough explanation of the NAHRA Hunt Test program, which is a lot different than our tests here in Germany (or England). All of the Participants were amazed at how laid back and simple the Test Program is, as the Tests that are run here are very regimented. After the explanation, we ran through the "Started" test (not very successfully), which everybody enjoyed, especially when Jack started calling the Ducks in and telling the Dog Handlers to get their butts on the seat as the Ducks were coming in.

Thanks to the knowledge and professionalism of Jack and Phyllis, along with the support and sponsorship of Tri-tronics, the weekend was a great success (despite the language barrier) and an experience that we would like to repeat in the near future.

If everything goes according to plan, Jack and Phyllis will be visiting us again next year when we hope to run a weekend of NAHRA Hunt Tests, as well as another Seminar.

It remains for me to say thank you very much to Jack and Phyllis for taking the time to come and give us a very interesting insight to the "American Way" and to Tri-Tronics for Sponsoring the event.




