

## President's Bark by Jack Jagoda



I recently received a request for historical information regarding the origin and purpose of the NAHRA Regional Field Test, held annually in each region. To properly address this it is important to understand some additional facts about NAHRA. I feel that occasionally we need to reflect on our origin for the folks that have just joined us.

For many years, clubs and individual gun dog enthusiasts held local field trials for the hunter and his retriever. In 1983, NAHRA was founded and became the first

national organization to find test and reward retrievers against a written standard. It was quickly apparent that once dogs earned titles, their owners often did not renew their NAHRA membership. With the continued interest and growth we needed experienced individuals to manage clubs and educate new members. We had to find a way to encourage people to stay involved year after year. In 1988 the NAHRA Invitational was born. This national event was limited to the 30, high point dogs in North America. Another dilemma surfaced as the number of points required to participate, more than doubled in two years. The high point dog earned 540 points creating yet another problem. Soon we were measuring wallets and not dogs as originally intended. The points race was ended as the NAHRA Invitational was opened to all dogs that earn 100 points or fie senior qualifications in the previous calendar year. The number of dogs eligible to participate soared from thirty to over two hundred.

The Invitational continues to draw people from across our NAHRA land. The 1999 NAHRA Invitational will be held at historic Linden Farm, located in Northern Virginia.

Very few people own dogs capable of qualifying for the national event. Others can't spare the time away from home or work. It was evident that additional levels of participation would be appropriate. The NAHRA Regional Field Test was created to recognize Started and Intermediate dogs and their owners at a weekend long event, held

annually in each of our NAHRA regions. Owners that qualify their dogs for this event receive a gold duck band and are invited to participate. Check the NAHRA schedule of events for the Regional Field Test near you.

I am quite pleased to announce that I was offered a collection of books from the personal library of Richard A. Wolters. There is a small book in the collection titled, "Retrievers", by the English author B.B. Riviere, written in 1947. In the introduction, the author writes, "The association between man and dog appears to be as old as man himself, and its' origin lost in the shadowland before the dawn of history. So old is it, that the love of man is now inborn and instinctive in all dogs and his companionship necessary to their happiness. It is always a matter for wonder to me to see quite small puppies, despite the companionship of their own kind, crying and fretting for the presence of a human being.

By some of mankind at least, this unique and immemorial bond is recognized and the feeling reciprocated, and to the happiness of many men and women, the companionship of dogs is equally essential."

I wish each of you the personal joy I have shared with my dogs and the best of luck to you and yours in the coming year.



#### **UPDATE**:

The most frequently missed question on the NAHRA Judge's Test is... # 58 - "A dog unwilling to release a bird to a handler shall be eliminated immediately."

(Think about this, and the stake you are judging.)

The following pledge is being added to the Judge's List book:

#### To be a NAHRA Judge is both an honor and a privelege.

- Judges accept the responsibility to represent NAHRA in an honest, fair and courteous manner. Judges have the opportunity and duty to uphold the ideals of NAHRA and what the program stands for.
- Judges should have an attitude that gives and demands respect.
- A judging assignment is very important because we are passing judgement on our members' dogs in accordance with the General Procedures, Regulations and Field Procedures and Judging Guidelines for NAHRA.
- We need to select judges that are experienced and unbiased, for by their verdicts, they are in control of our future breeding stock of hunting retrievers.
- NAHRA judges must be members in good standing and current with their membership dues. The NAHRA
  judge book is published twice a year and distributed to NAHRA member clubs.
- Judges who are not current with their dues, will not be included in the book and will be required to reapply to become a judge and take another judges test.


Have you ever thought about becoming a judge? The first thing to realize is that judging is not for everyone. Be honest and ask yourself..."Do I have the time and can I be committed? Do I have the patience, understanding, and am I willing to work with my co-judge and the dog handlers? Am I thoroughly familiar with the rulebook?"

It is an honor and a privilege to be a NAHRA judge. As a judge you accept the responsibility to represent NAHRA in an honest, fair and courteous manner. You must be experienced and unbiased. Judges must be current members in good standing with NAHRA. . (To insure that your membership doesn't lapse, check the expiration date on your membership card and send in your renewal at least 15 days before that date).

NAHRA rulebooks and judges tests are available by request from the NAHRA office. There is also a Judge's book, which contains a list of all approved NAHRA judges and their judging points, available for a fee of \$5.00 from the NAHRA office. Your completed judge's application/test must be submitted with a \$10.00 fee. The next judges' book will be published in July, 1999. Only judges who are current NAHRA members at the time of printing will be included. Judges who allow their membership to expire may be required to reapply and retake the judges' test.






As with any undertaking, we would have not been able to carry out this event without several people ensuring that everything was properly arranged. We owe a big thanks to David McLaughlin,



## JUDGE'S CLINIC



#### Can a dog "switch" in a started stake?

This is a question that may arise as a result of a poorly designed started test. Traditionally we only think of switching as going to the area of a fallen bird during a multiple marking test, then leaving and establishing a hunt in the area of another fall (rulebook section 24). Chapter III, Section 1, states that a *Started* Hunting Retriever Field Test shall consist of 5 single bird marking tests. Technically, it is impossible to switch on a single.

A dog that leaves the area of fallen bird or does not go directly to it may be suspect in the following areas; 1) the dog has failed to clearly prove he has marked the bird, 2) the dog is disturbing cover unnecessarily, 3) the dog lacks perseverance, 4) the dog may be exhibiting a lack of "nose", or scent ability. Before a decision is made to eliminate a dog we must be cerain the fall was clearly visible and the dog was not distracted in any way. Both judges should discuss the situation and come to a conclusion.

Occasionally a Started test is set up where there is inadequate separation between the single marks of a series. In addition, there can be strong temptation to return to a previous fall by virtue of terrain, scent, wind, or excessive bird thrower activity.

When setting up a Started test, it is the judge's responsibility to consider the inexperience and impulsiveness of started dogs, coupled with a naïve handler. I always recommend doing started marks, especially landmarks, as a walking course, in which there are separate points of origins and distinct areas of fall for each of the marks.


I personally do not favor walkups for started dogs. Again, the inexperience of the dog and handler often make a walkup so stressful that the dog cannot be judged fairly. Started dogs are so easily distracted by all kinds of things. They deserve the best possible opportunity to get settled at the point of origin, hear a call, to look out and see a well defined arc of a thrown or shot bird, getting a shot at the top of the arc.

Additionally, it is important to mark the point of origin for the handler (I recommend flagging or spray paint on some part of the natural growth). Likewise, some flagging where the fall should land is useful both in helping the handler orient himself and the dog toward the fall, and quickly determining a "no bird". It is my opinion that if the dog is sitting quietly at the point of origin, but obviously does not see a fall, he should be given a rerun. This is a marking test. The dog should have an opportunity to If the dog, however, is wild and mark. jumping around at the point of origin, not because of distraction, but due to lack of discipline, I am less sympathetic.

We often find the least experienced help at the started stake, as well as, inconsistent throws, inadequate calls, poorly timed shots. I would encourage all clubs to invest in gun holders and various mechanical throwers (wingers, strong-arm launchers) to improve the quality of Stared tests. The Started stake is often the first look many people get at our testing program. It should represent the *BEST* we have to offer, not what is left after all the other stakes are manned.

In summary, a Started dog that goes to the area of the fall, establishes a hunt then leaves that area to return to an area of a previous fall, can be eliminated. Hopefully, however, a well-conceived and properly conducted stake will preclude this happening.






