

When NAHRA dropped the Invitational (National event) for several years, Lars and Lenda Barker were the ones to instigate it again by organizing the Invitational at Scenic Mesa Ranch in Hotchkiss, Colorado in 2006 and it has been strong again ever since.


In 1996 **Lolenda Labs** made "Hunting Dog History" when their Dam (GMHRCH Lacy Lee of Lolenda) and her three pups (Lolenda's GMHR Caballero Blanco, MHR Chantilly Lace of Lolenda and MHR Lolenda's Pulco Negro) all qualified and competed at the Invitational (National Hunting Event). For three years in a row, **Lacy**, was one of the top 40 dogs in the country to be invited to the Invitational, where NAHRA paid travel, hotel and transportation for handlers and dogs. What an experience and honor that was!

Lolenda Labs had four Grandmaster Hunting Retriever Champions in their line and countless Started Retrievers, Hunters, Working Retrievers and Master Hunter Retrievers. Their line has also extended into HRC and AKC events including additional Junior Hunters, Senior Hunters and Master Hunters.

The **Barker's** contribution of \$10,000 to help with the 'start up fee' for clubs to host the Invitational for the next 20 years is an effort to keep **NAHRA** the best "Hunting Dog Organization in the country!"

Sadly, the North American Hunting Retriever Association has lost one of its true champions. Dan Hosford has been promoting, supporting and influencing the hunting retriever for a long time. He trained hunting retrievers in North Idaho (Silver Valley, Hayden Lake) and the Spokane area (Medical Lake, Espanola) for himself and for others. He has had direct influence on many, many outstanding retrievers. He has had the same influence on thousands of retriever owners. He traveled and had clientele from Edmonton, AB to Yuma, AZ providing services of training, teaching and entering hunting retriever tests.

Dan was somewhat of a dog behaviorist. He knew what made them tick. But his talent of dealing with inexperienced, not knowing owners/handlers was fantastic. It's difficult to say if he was better at training dogs or better at training people. Training a team was his forte. His TV show "Working Man's Retriever" provide basic common methods that was beneficial to many viewers. Dan was very proud of that series. He also has training programs on video.

Personally I always had the utmost respect for Dan. As a dog trainer, as a handler and as a person. He was very professional, direct, humorous and completely likeable. He had the most positive influence on the hunting retriever movement throughout the West and was one of NAHRA's staunchest advocates.

A lot of people are going to miss Dan. But the ones than will miss him most are the four-legged ones whether they know it or not.




