

NAHRA Invitational Judges Selection Process Criteria (all candidates)

- 1. Must be nominated through Regional process
- 2. Must be approved by BOD
- 3. Must be compliant with all current standard judging criteria
- 4. Must have attended Judges' Clinic within last three years
- 5. Must have participated in at least one Invitational as a handler
- 6. Must have at least ten Senior judging points
- 7. Must have judged a Licensed Senior category Field Test within last three years

Criteria (previous Invitational judge candidates)

- 1. Must not have judged an Invitational within last five years
- 2. Must have earned at least five Senior qualifications as a handler since judging previous Invitational
- 3. Must have judged a Licensed Senior category Field Test within last three years

*A waiver of any of the criteria may be authorized by the BOD under special circumstances.

** In the event of two equally qualified candidates, preference should be given to the judging candidate that has not previously served as an Invitational judge.

Qualities of an Invitational Judge

- Understands and promotes NAHRA's core values
- · Has contributed to the NAHRA program
- Works well with others
- Is experienced in dog knowledge (training, handling, hunting)
- Has demonstrated realistic, fair and worthy test set ups
- · Understands potential logistical implications of large scale, high profile event

Process to be effective for all Invitational events after January 1, 2015
