



NAHRA Regional Director (RD)

The North American Hunting Retriever Association (NAHRA) is geographically organized in Regions. Each Region has one elected Regional Director.

The NAHRA Bylaws list duties and responsibilities of the RD.

“Regional Directors shall be responsible for communication between the Board of Directors and all NAHRA members in their region regardless of club affiliation or not. Regional Directors shall serve as members of the Board of Directors during their term. Regional Directors are responsible for representing the interests of their respective regions in accord with the Bylaws and Articles of Association. Regional Directors shall coordinate with the club representatives in scheduling events. Regional Directors shall have the responsibility of reporting to the EBOD allegations of misconduct brought to their attention.”

The following are additional expectations/duties of the Regional Director position:

Abide by all Rules & Regulations of NAHRA including the Code of Conduct and all aspects of the NAHRA Bylaws.

Initiate actions to increase the number of clubs and the number of members within the Region.

Maintain and manage a Regional Fund if approved by the clubs within the Region. All Region Clubs should be stakeholders in that fund in as such be voting members of expenditures and transactions.

Coordinate and compile an annual schedule of events (events include Field Tests, Regional Field Test, Judge’s Clinic, Fund Raisers) hosted by Region clubs.

Submit a tentative schedule of events to the NAHRA office prior to January 1 of each year.

Regional Directors will establish a list of NAHRA Club Representatives for each club within their Region and provide that list to the NAHRA Office. This list is to be updated annually during January of each year.

Disseminate all pertinent information from the NAHRA Board of Directors (BOD) with the Club Representatives and share all necessary communications from the Region members with the BOD.

Ensure the club’s within your Region are compliant with the NAHRA Rules & Regulations at all events when you are in attendance.

Attend as many events within the Region as possible.
